

## MCAC MEN'S DIVISION BASKETBALL OPERATING CODE

### I. Coaches Organization

- A. All MCAC coaches are members of the coaches organization. Each college is allowed one vote.
- B. The president of the MCAC basketball coaches association will be the head coach of the tournament host school.
- C. The annual meeting will be held in coordination with the MCAC tournament and will be held on the Thursday evening prior to the tournament. The tournament host will set the meeting site and time.

### II. Competitive Season

- A. No supervised or organized practice may start earlier than October 1.
- B. The first scheduled game may not be played before November 1. However, an alumni basketball game may be played before the first allowable contest.

### III. Rules and Regulations

- A. The MCAC Ejection Policy shall apply to all men's basketball games, not just the conference contests.
- B. Scheduling
  - 1. Division schedule will be approved at the MCAC annual meeting.
  - 2. Colleges will arrange their own non-division games.
  - 3. The master division schedule serves as a binding contract for division games. It is recommended that colleges exchange contracts/confirmations on all games.
- C. Eligibility

All athletes must be eligible under NJCAA rules for all competition covered by the rules.
- D. Tie Breaking Procedures: Southern and Northern Divisions
  - 1. In the event of a two-way tie for a division championship, the team entered in the #1 position will be determined by the following procedure:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. Coin Toss
  - 2. In the event of a three-way tie for a division championship, tournament

participants will be determined on the basis of:

- a. Won-loss records head to head.
  - b. Best record against the next highest division team. If one team has a better record versus the highest remaining team they will be the division champions for playoff purposes. If two teams remain tied they will have a playoff game. In the event all teams remain tied with the same record against the next highest division team, you compare all teams' record against the next highest division team until you have exhausted division teams. At that point, if there is still a tie of three or more teams, a draw will determine the bottom spot or spots and the remaining two teams will playoff for the divisional champion and runner-up.
3. In the event of a four-way tie for a division championship, tournament participants will be determined on the basis of:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. See item 2-b.
  4. In the event of a five-way tie for a division championship, tournament participants will be determined on the basis of:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. See item 2-b.
  5. In the event of a tie for second or third place, that does not effect any entry to the state tournament, tournament participants will be determined on the basis of:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. Won-loss record vs champion.
    - c. Won-loss record vs runner-up.
    - d. A coin flip to determine positions.
  6. In the event of a four-way tie for second place, tournament participants will be determined by:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. Won-loss record vs champion.
    - b. A draw for the #2 and #3 positions, with the remaining two teams involved in play-off with the winner receiving #4 position and the loser eliminated.
  7. In the event of a three-way tie for third place, tournament participants will be determined by:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. Won-loss record vs champion.
    - c. Won-loss record vs runner-up.
    - d. A draw for the #4 position, with the remaining two teams involved in a play-off game, with the winner to be #3 position, and the loser eliminated.
  8. In the event of a four-way tie for third place, tournament participants will be determined by:
    - a. Won-loss records head to head.
    - b. Won-loss records vs champion.
    - c. Won-loss records vs runner-up.
    - d. A draw for two play-off games, with the winners advancing to the state tournament and losers eliminated.
    - e. Once the winners have been determined from play-off games, a coin flip will determine #3 and #4 positions.
  9. In the event of a two-way tie for fourth place, tournament participants will be

determined by:

- a. Won-loss records head to head.
  - b. If each team won one of the two division games, a play-off game will be held to decide the #4 position.
10. In the event of a three-way tie for fourth place, tournament participants will be determined by:
- a. Won-loss records head to head.
  - b. Won-loss records vs champion.
  - c. Won-loss records vs runner-up.
  - d. Won-loss records vs third place team.
  - e. A draw to select one team eliminated. A play-off game will be held between the other two teams.
11. In the event of a four-way tie for fourth place, tournament participants will be determined by:
- a. Won-loss records head to head.
  - b. Won-loss records vs champion.
  - c. Won-loss records vs runner-up.
  - c. Won-loss records vs third place team.
  - e. Draw two teams for a play-off game.
12. In the event a play-off game is needed, it shall be scheduled by mutual consent no later than the Wednesday preceding the MCAC Tournament at a site to be determined by a coin flip. The game may be played at a neutral site by mutual consent.
13. When criteria is used in ties of more than two teams, a team may criteria into the State tournament by a better record than the other teams or criteria out of consideration for entry based on a worse record than the other teams.

E. Statistics

There is to be one set of statistics for the entire season. The Minnesota Community College Conference (MCAC) statistics for men's basketball will be calculated and distributed by the Conference Coordinator's Office.

IV. Division Organization

A. There shall be two (2) divisions:

B. Division Game Rules

1. The home college must have a basketball rule book available at the scorer's table.
2. During play in any basketball game, the area immediately under each basket shall be kept free of any non-playing persons, equipment, signs, and banners. The area is defined as the free-throw line, extended and/or in front of wall pads.
3. Home team responsible for providing statistics at half time and after the game.
4. Home team is responsible for filming the game and providing immediate copy for the visiting team after the game in DVD format.
5. For all games between MCAC colleges, teams shall wear white jerseys at home and dark jerseys away from home.
6. Each home team shall furnish six balls for warm-up to the visiting team. The NIKE ball will be the official conference ball for 2008-2009.
7. All Saturday games that are a result of the needed road trip shall be afternoon games, unless mutually agreed upon. (Northern Division)
8. When men and women have games on the same day, they shall be at 6:00 and 8:00 p.m. on week days. When there is a single men's game, it shall be at 7:30 p.m. Non-school day start times are at 1:00/3:00 or 6:00/8:00 and are set by the home team, except for a Saturday following a Friday contest where the start times must be 1:00 and 3:00 PM.
9. Basketball statistics shall be in by Monday 11:00 AM.

C. Inter-Division Games

Inter-divisional games on Friday nights are to be played at 6:00/8:00 unless mutually agreed upon; and inter-divisional games on Saturdays are to be played at 1:00/3:00. If there is only one game scheduled on Saturday, the contest will be at 1:00 unless there is mutual consent for a different starting time. All inter-division games must be played on the date scheduled.

V. Awards Procedures

A. All-Division Selection

The number of All-Division players shall be 15 in both the North and South the top 5 in each division will be automatically named " All State", with the remaining 5 slots determined by a coaches vote.

1. No coach will list any of his own team members.
2. The top 15 players (point-wise) in the two divisions become the All-Division team. These names become the nominees for the All-State team, and will be listed in rank order by division.
3. The top two players in each division automatically become region nominees.

B. All MCAC Team

1. The top 5 players from the two divisions are automatically All-State. The coaches then would vote for 5 other players to complete the All-State team.
2. Coaches will then rank the top 3 from the automatic selections.

3. If the All-Conference balloting deadlines are not met, players from the

delinquent college(s) will not be considered for All-Division or All-Conference honors.

C. Coach of the Year

1. The men's basketball "coach of the year" for each division. Will be determined by coaches vote by the coaches for their division only.
2. The voting is to be done by secret ballot, each year, with one vote per school.

VI. State Tournament Policies

A. Date/Location

1. All colleges are eligible to host the MCAC tournament.
2. Colleges bidding for the tournament must apply to the MCAC Men's Basketball Coaches Association prior to the MCAC annual meeting.
3. A college shall host the tournament two years.
4. The MCAC Men's Basketball Association will recommend the tournament location to the MCAC General Assembly.
5. The date and location of the tournament are established at the annual MCAC spring meeting.

B. Type of Tournament

1. The tournament will be an eight team, single elimination, consolation bracket tournament.
2. Region 13 qualification. The top three teams from the MCAC Tournament will qualify for the Region 13 Tournament. The champion will host on years Minnesota is scheduled to host the Region 13 Tournament.
1. The top four teams from Northern and Southern Division will qualify for the State Tournament.
4. Pairings:  
Top Bracket: S-1 vs N-4      S-3 vs N-2  
Bottom Bracket: S-2 vs N-3      S-4/N5 vs N-1  
\* The host team will determine which bracket plays in the afternoon or evening sessions. The brackets must remain intact.
5. Starting times for games on Day 1 and Day 2 shall be: 1:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m., 6:30 p.m., and 8:30 p.m.
6. Starting times for Day 3 tournament games shall be 12:00 noon, 2:00 p.m., and 4:00 p.m.
